Chief Dahlman will talk to the District Accountant to see if this is standard practice.

Resignation Announcement

President Woodard announced his resignation from the Board of Directors, effective immediately as he presented a letter to the Board Members. Vice-President Alan Lee stepped into the role of President and thanked Ron Woodard for his years of service. Discussion of Nancy Oksenholt's appointment to Position #1 was tabled until later in the meeting so Dan Drayton could take part when he arrived.

New Business

Item #3 - Grievance Over Staffing

The Board reviewed copies of documents pertaining to the Grievance filed by the Union over Staffing. The trending deficit shortfall is \$70,000; 33% of the way into the budget year, Overtime is at 39.3% of the budget. Chief Dahlman reported that if the Union

doesn't accept the District's response, the matter will go to Arbitration. Once he receives the final document from the attorney, he will email it to the Board members.

Item #4 – Policy 8.15 – Workers Compensation Insurance & Return to Work

The Board reviewed Policy 8.15 – Workers Compensation Insurance & Return to Work with the recommended changes.

Jamie Wright made a motion to approve Policy 8.15 – Workers Compensation Insurance & Return to Work with recommended changes; Dan Drayton seconded the motion. The motion passed. **(See Motion # 6)**

Item # 5 – Appointment of Nancy Oksenholt to Board of Directors Position #1

With the arrival of Dan Drayton, the Board reviewed the appointment of Nancy Oksenholt to Position #1 to complete Ron Woodard's term that expires 6/30/23. Nancy would add her name to the May 2023 ballot for consideration by the voters to fill that position for the regular three-year term.

Tim Beatty made a motion to appoint Nancy Oksenholt to Position #1 to fill Ron Woodard's term that expires 6/30/23; Jamie Wright seconded the motion. The motion passed. **(See Motion #7).** President Lee administered the oath of office and Nancy took her place at the Board table.

Safety Committee

• Safety Committee Meetings are held every other month – the next one is scheduled for November 21, 2022.

Fire Marshal

- Fire Prevention Week was October 9-15th; the District provided education to over 370 students. Riley Schroeder did a great job of organizing the week's events and C-Shift participated in the presentations.
- Monday morning there will be an online presentation on software that will allow us to complete pre-incident plans and fire inspections. We are looking into a grant that would fund the first year of the software and equipment.

<u>Training</u>

- Fire 9 hours, EMS 1 hour.
- Aerial operator class is scheduled for December 10th & 11th.

Chief's Report

Chief Dahlman went over some of the highlights of his report which was included in the Board packet:

- FEMA Covid:
 - All accounting completed and final documents have been signed.
 - The unused \$506,440.75 was returned to them.
- EMS report:
 - 5 transports in October
 - Ambulance transport dollars received FY22-23 budget year is \$19,515
 - 64 transports in billing with PWA
- Monies received:
 - \$ 564 EF Recovery
 - \$ 5,329 Ambulance collections
 - \$ 600 Surplus Escape Air system (Govdeals)
- Conflagration Reimbursement:
 - Miller Rd \$19,234 (received)
 - o Klamath County \$22,551
 - Rum Creek \$94,868
- Building and Equipment Maintenance:
 - Dry rot repairs at Station 16 are waiting on stainless steel vents to complete the work.
 - Electronic signs for stations 14 and 16 not yet ordered, looking for additional information from Foress Signs. Will work with the City on permits.
 - Vehicle maintenance and winter inspections, tires for 3 vehicles.
 - One new engine has arrived, the other due on November 18th both will need to be equipped.
- Alarm Responses:
 - October alarm responses 311, up 6% over October of last year. Current average is 9.8 calls per day, total call for the year as of end of October is 2,957. For the year 2022 we are 97 calls ahead of 2021 for an increase this current year of 3.5%.
- Grant applications:
 - SDAO Safety and Security Grant for security lighting at Stations 12, 13, and 17 no response yet.
 - The \$65,000 grant request made to Tillamook County for a heavy lift drone still no response, expect that it will not be funded.
 - OSFM Tender Request is still being evaluated.
- Bond Purchases:
 - One Type-1 engine has been delivered and radios installed, the other arrived with a cracked windshield which is being replaced. Equipment installation, radios, MDTs are all being scheduled, hope to have both engines in service the first of the year.

- Ambulance preliminary contract has been signed, making sure we have all the proper documentation. Waiting for purchasing agreement from our attorney as this is considered a "Cooperative Purchase", will be published Tuesday, November 15th.
- Personnel and Hiring:
 - Three volunteers in training, three new applicants going through initial orientation.
 - o 20 active volunteers currently on the roster.
- Surplus Property:
 - Declaring the trailer and Transit. The Transit will go to Power Ford, and we'll advertise the trailer on our own and through word-of-mouth.
- Audit and Accounting:
 - We have received a "draft" of the 2021/2022 audit, last remaining documents have been sent. Expect to be completed and submitted to the State of Oregon on time.
- FYI Information:
 - On Halloween we handed out candy and stickers at the Outlet Mall. A few kids dropped by Station 14 to trick-or-treat.
 - Toy Drive is gearing up buckets have been dropped off. Delivery is the morning of December 17th and the Christmas party sponsored by the Volunteers is that evening.
 - The Board authorized distribution of \$50 gift cards to the employees and Volunteers like last year – cards will be purchased through Kenny's IGA – total amount \$2,600.
